

MIG-29A FULCRUM

The aviation world has been aware of the MIG-29 since 1977 when it was spotted by a satellite orbiting above Ramensksoye, but it was not until 1986 that the western world had a better look at the Fulcrum. At that time, six MIG-29"s made a surprise visit to Finland, but photographers were kept at a distance, maintaining the veil of secrecy that surrounded this aircraft.

In 1988 two MIG-29 aircraft appeared at the Farnsborough Air Show, put on a spectacular flight demonstration and allowed the press to photograph almost to their total wishes - not quite, but almost! This is when the world learned that the MIG-29 is an outstanding fighter, equal to anything produced in the western world, but for far less money.

When Glasnost opened the Soviet doors, the MIG-29 variants were made available to the industry, press and opposing air force intelligence departments. Even the model industry was permitted to closely inspect and photograph the MIG-29 near Moscow. Many goodwill flights have been made by the Russian and Ukraine teams to countries all over the world. Their outstanding flight characteristics have made the flight demo teams extremely popular with the hundreds of thousands of spectators who have seen one or more of the flight demonstrations.





9 ASSEMBLY OF EXHAUST CONE









