


**Supermarine Spitfire  
Mk.IX UTI****History in brief**

In the absence of an official two-seater variant, a number of airframes were crudely converted in the field. These included a 4 Squadron SAAF Mk VB in North Africa, where a second seat was fitted instead of the upper fuel tank in front of the cockpit, although it was not a dual-control aircraft and is thought to have been used as the squadron "run-about." The only unofficial two-seat conversions that were fitted with dual-controls were a small number of Russian lend/lease Mk IX aircraft. These were referred to as Mk IX UTI and differed from the Supermarine proposals by using an inline "greenhouse" style double canopy rather than the raised "bubble" type of the T Mk VIII.

Armament: 2 machine-guns 12,7 mm

**Historie**

Na základě smlouvy o půjčce a pronájmu dodali Britové do SSSR 1186 Spitfirů LF Mk.IX a dva výškové stroje (ML229 a TA810). Právě pro boje na sovětsko-německé frontě měly hloubkové verze všechny předpoklady. Disponovaly dostatečnou palebnou silou a možnost zavěšení pum jejich akceschopnosti ještě umocnila. Tyto dva faktory a skutečnost, že vynikaly v malých letových hladinách, dávaly letounům široké možnosti použití.

Pro školení pilotů sloužila v SSSR vlastní úprava s dvojím řízením., označená podle tamních zvyklostí Mk.IX UTI. Za kabinou byl vytvořen prostor druhého pilota, chráněný průhledným překrytem, odsouvatelným dozadu.








**1** Spitfire Mk. IXUTI, White 30, Ramenskoye AFB, Soviet Air Force, cca 1947

Sky type S with red star the spinners.




**2** Spitfire Mk. IXUTI, RED 17, DOSAAF aeroclub, Tallin, mid-fifties

Aircraft used as the trainer in Soviet aeroclub was painted in typical scheme of DOSAAF aircraft, White over Light Blue. Red bands on fuselage and rudder. (What if camouflage)



**3** Spitfire Mk. IXUTI, unknown unit of Soviet AF, cca 1945

Trainer aircraft painted in AMT-24 Green overall with no tactical markings. One of the few known from the photographic evidence.



**4** Spitfire Mk. IXUTI, Blue 7, CAGI institute, cca 1946.

Aircraft used for various testing in CAGI was painted in combination of Ocean Grey and Dark Green. Yellow the spinners.


