The Battleship Yamato's nine 18.1° guns were mounted in 3 advanced, heavily armored turrets weighing 2,730 tons each. These guns weighed some 180 tons each and fired 3,218lbs armor piercing shells up to 25 miles away with a rate of fire of 2 RPM. The Yamato never tested her guns against another battleship, but she did manage to sink an American Destroyer and an Escort carrier before she herself was sent to rest at the bottom of the sea.








APPLYING DECALS

- 1.Clean the model surface with a wet cloth.
- 2.Cut out each decal design from sheet, and dip it in tepid water for 15-20 sec.
- 3. Hold the backing sheet edge and slide decal onto the model.
- 4. Move decal into position by wetting decal with finger.
- 5. Press decal gently down with a soft cloth until excess water and air bubbles are gone.
