BOOMERS IN CAMOUFLAGE (abbreviated from squadron history published in The Hook, 190. Printed with permission)

In summer 1989, VA-165 painted aircraft in temporary camouflage to test and use the color scheme to tactical advantage at Red Flag. Results were positive, however one downside noted was that during flights over the desert, the camouflage was so effective that pilots lost visual contact. The paint was waterbased and applied over existing paint. Once back at Whidbey, the paint was removed.

Phase II was at sea in winter 1990. The paint was tested for resistance to sea spray and catapult steam.
